

Online Terms & Conditions of Use for Subjects of Health and Medical Assessments

1. Introduction

Welcome to TheScreeningLab!

The following Online Terms & Conditions of Use explain in simple words what our system does, what “subjects of assessments” (you) can expect from us, and what we expect from you.

If you agree to what you read below, you should click "Yes" at the end of these Online Terms & Conditions of Use to acknowledge your consent and agreement. This will be the legal equivalent of your signature on a written contract, and equally binding. Only by clicking “Yes” will you be able to access and use the Services available on this TheScreeningLab.

2. T&Cs

2.1. What is TheScreeningLab (TSL)?

Your organisation is using TSL software under license to assess patients’ /subjects’ levels of medical and physical fitness and other characteristics in order to prevent injuries, optimize rehabilitation and promote general health and wellness.

TSL is a cloud-based service to digitise any paper-based assessment - physical, medical, functional, diagnostic – that offers an array of solutions including:

- Automated result analysis specific to age and gender specific benchmarks, or customised norms
- Automated reporting and tracking of progress in graphical form
- Problem solving with automated intervention or progressive exercise programs generated for any identified weak area.

2.2. What advantages do you receive from the use of TSL?

Regular screenings represent the best way to track in the long term your levels of fitness ensuring that they remain at optimal levels for your age, gender and lifestyle.

TSL transforms screening results in intuitive reports to help you and the health providers you decide to share these reports with, to identify objectively your areas of personal strength and potential weakness.

Where possible, TSL offers solutions for any areas of potential weakness, providing a safe and progressive personalised 6 week injury minimisation/rehabilitation exercise program or other suggested form of intervention.

The interventions suggested are intended as a guideline to be performed under supervision: please discuss any intervention devised for you by TSL with your GP or specialist, physiotherapist, exercise physiologist or other relevant health professional to ensure it is implemented correctly and safely.



2.3. What personal information does TSL collect and how is this information used?

TSL uses your personal information in the algorithms that calculate age / gender specific benchmarks for the tests used for your assessments and to provide the related injury prevention and rehabilitation support programs your organisation has subscribed for.

You, your organisation or external providers involved in the assessment processes will upload on TSL a variety of information about you, including:

- your **email address (*)** - used as your unique identifier to log-in and access with your secret password your results
- typically, your **name and surname** – although your organisation may choose to assign an anonymous alias instead
- your **gender (*)** - used to compare you with a male or female data-set; note you are free to specify your gender
- your **date of birth (*)** - used to compare you with the relevant age data-set
- your **dominant side** (left or right handed) **(*)** – collected for possible future statistical analysis of results
- your contact details - not mandatory - e.g. address, phone number
- cultural background and preferred sports - not mandatory – for possible future statistical segmentation of results
- the results of your assessments and questionnaires

() = Mandatory field*

In addition to the information indicated above, your organisation may specifically require additional data to better manage your individual case, which may be either mandatory or optional (for example, your job title, your employee number, work location, etc).

2.4. What access do you have to your personal information?

This depends on your organization. Some organisations allow access to subjects only on a restricted basis and you will need to request assistance from within your organisation.

Most organisations set up TSL to allow subjects unrestricted access the information stored about themselves and if this is your case you can log-in using your username (email address provided) and your secret password at the page <http://app.thescreeninglab.com/user/login> .

Clicking on “My Profile” you can view and edit your personal details stored on the system while your dashboard gives you full access to all the results of your assessments including:

- the reports of assessments already completed
- the categorized tracking graph of the completed assessment results
- the list of pending assessment scheduled for you

Should you experience difficulties in accessing your information, you have the right to require access to your records by making a written request to the relevant officers inside your organisation.



2.5. Who can access your personal information?

TSL considers sensitive and private any aspect of the information collected on you, including the results of your screenings or questionnaires and the preventative exercise programs produced for you

Your personal information is available only to:

- **you**
- the **relevant practitioners and managers** of areas inside your organisation granted the access to your case
- the **health professionals** involved with the execution of the different assessments and the evaluation of the results

Your personal information will not be disclosed to third parties unless written permission is given by your organisation or you.

Third party service providers, such as IT and software service providers, providers of research services, our professional advisers such as security consultants and auditors, may have limited or full access to the system's database for scheduled maintenance and repairs, quality assurance testing, programmed audits purposes.

TSL reserves the right to use all collected and de-identify data for future statistical analysis. All such data will be completely de-identified so that it will be impossible to re-connect it to you or your organisation.
